About this Qualification

This innovative course provides a successful learner with a **Full Paediatric First Aid Certification**. Therefore **meeting the Ofsted EYFS requirements** for a first aider for infants, children and anyone under 18 years of age. The qualifications are delivered together as over **6 hours** of practical training and at home **6 hours** e-Learning.

We suggest that the **e-Learning is completed prior to the practical day** as learners will be assessed on all areas of content. As per HSE guidelines we restrict our courses to 12 learners per trainer - although there is no limit to the number of learners you may include as we can supply multiple trainers.

Practical Day:

Takes place at one of our open venues

e-Learning:

Access codes are released on booking. Learners can complete this section in stages but we do ask that the module is completed prior to the practical day as they will be assessed on the content. As per the HSE guidance the full course must be completed **within 6 weeks**. If the e-Learning is not completed within 6 weeks of the practical sessions learners certificates will be downgraded to an Emergency Paediatric.

Learners are continuously assessed by the Trainer/Assessor. Learners attending this course should be aware of the responsibilities of a First Aider. All learners will be assessed whilst demonstrating first aid skills in a real-life scenario, they will therefore be required to kneel on the floor during recovery and CPR assessment. Learners will also have to successfully pass an end of course multiple-choice questionnaire in order to be certificated.

Refresher Training

The HSE recommend learners update their skills annually. Tigerlily Training provide free online refresher training.



Certification

On completion of the course learners receive a Full Paediatric First Aid certificate. Your certificate will comply with the requirements of the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, supported by the guidance provided by Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981 and suitable for EPA (End Point Assessment) for the Early Years Educator.
